To whom it may concern,

553366 A40 Wilton Controlled Crossing

I wish to inform you that Kier will be undertaking various works at the above location on behalf of Highways England.

The works will involve installation of a controlled Toucan crossing on the A40 (eastside of Wilton Roundabout) updating lighting columns and construction of a shared footway/cycle path. Vegetation clearance and tree trimming will also be carried out on the roundabout.

For your information, the details of the project are summarized below:

Planned Start Date: 18 September 2017**Planned Completion Date:** 04 December 2017**Hours of work:** 20:00 – 06:00

These dates are subject to change, dependent on weather conditions. However, we can assure you, that you will be kept fully informed of any amendments to the works schedule.

Access to businesses and residential properties will be maintained at all times.

Traffic Restrictions

Traffic management will be installed in nine phases, consisting predominantly of night time lane closures and some night time full closures with a diversion route as and when required.

Diversion Route

Traffic will be directed north on the A49 to its Junction with A417, here traffic will continue southbound on A417 to Ledbury, at which point none motorway traffic will be directed southbound onto the A449 and continue southbound to its junction with the A40. Motorway traffic at Ledbury will continue on the A417 to its junction with the M50 at junction 2, here they will join the M50 and continue southbound to its end merging onto A40/A449 junction.

Advanced signage on M50 and A449. To leave at M50 Junction 2 continuing northbound onto A417. Non motorway traffic will be diverted northbound on A449 to the A4172 junction, head northbound on A4172, leading onto A417 to its junction with A49, join A49 heading southbound continuing south to re-join A40 at Wilton roundabout. Motorway traffic will be diverted off the A449 onto M50 and continue northbound to its junction with A417 (junction 2) from here traffic will continue on non motorway traffic diversion route.

We'd advise all motorists to use the signed diversion route as we have carefully chosen this with suitability and safety in mind. We'd also encourage all drivers to stick to speed limits and follow appropriate signage to ensure the safety of those working on site and fellow road users.
