SUNDAY 21 NOVEMBER ROSS-ON-WYE CHRISTMAS FAYRE

This year's Christmas Fayre on Sunday was a huge success and another excellent event for the town with over 50 stalls selling arts, crafts, food and drink. EnviroAbility's Santa's Grotto, located at The Venue on Hill Street, proved really popular with the youngsters, with queues of people waiting up to an hour for their gifts.

Market stalls opened at 11am with most traders selling out of produce by mid-afternoon or having to source additional supplies for the remaining few hours. Visitors enjoyed the food and drink on offer, provided by market regular, Pitta Stop as well as the Beefy Boys, with mulled wine, cider and hot chocolate on offer outside the Market House.

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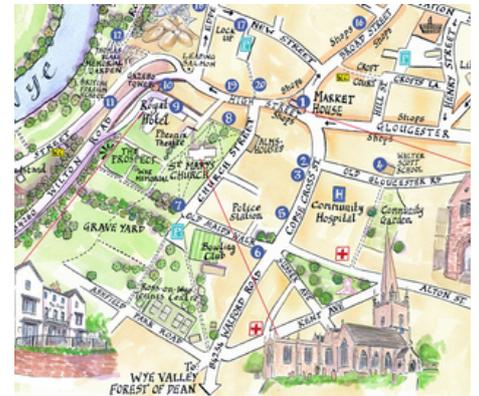
VISIT HEREFORDSHIRE TOURISM FORUM
