## Information for Christmas Fayre stallholders - Sunday 1 December 2024

## Criteria for stalls

The Council will consider the following criteria when accepting applications for stalls:

- They should sell good quality Christmas produce and products, such as toys, books, hand-made/homemade gifts/items, cold foods, sweets/confectionary, drinks, plants, flowers, artwork, metal work, jewellery and crafts, items in keeping with a traditional Christmas Fayre.
- Preference will be given to stall holders whose products will enhance the variety on offer, for example items which are different or unique and therefore improve the event and broaden the appeal. The aim of this is to minimise the duplication of stalls selling the same or similar items.
- The following items will not be allowed: open bottles of alcohol * cleaning products * slimming products * tobacco * tattooing * body piercing * smoking related items such as vaping or drug related paraphernalia * live fish, birds or animals* weapons (fake or replica) in any form * branded cosmetic health or beauty items * and jumble/bric-a-brac.
- Charity raffles/tombola stalls will be limited for the event.


## Acceptance of application

The final deadline for receiving applications is Friday $1^{\text {st }}$ November 2024. Please note stalls may sell out before this date so return your application quickly. Applications received after this date will not be considered.

Please note that requests to bring your own gazebo/trailer is not guaranteed and will depend on space available. Should this request not be confirmed you will be offered a standard stall which is provided by us.

The Council will notify applicants on the success of their application as soon as possible after receipt at which time payment will be requested.

Confirmation will then be given on receipt of the following:

- Payment for booking
- A copy of Public Liability Insurance, for the minimum amount of $£ 5$ million, which covers the date of the event (the certificate should clearly show policy start date and end date)
- A copy of any relevant food hygiene certificates

To ease arrival and unloading, stall arrivals will be staggered, applicants will be notified of their entry point and time slot approximately the week before.

## Information, Terms \& Conditions

- The Event runs between 11am and 5 pm .
- Standard size of stall is 8 feet $\times 4$ feet (ca $2.5 \mathrm{~m} \times 1.2 \mathrm{~m}$ ) and comes with a table and canopy which will be set up for you prior to your arrival. Chairs are not provided please feel free to bring your own.
- All rubbish must be removed from site and food outlets must provide bins.
- No vehicles (other than emergency services) permitted on site between 10.15am and 5pm.
- Pitches will be allocated by the Council. Requests for slots can be made but are not guaranteed.
- Fees are NON-REFUNDABLE and the event will go ahead in all weathers.
- In the event that the Council has to cancel the event full refunds will be given.
- Lighting is not provided on the stalls so feel free to bring your own. Note, there is no lighting other than the street lighting and no electricity is available on the streets.
- Electricity will not be supplied. Should you require power, quiet generators are permitted at most of our outdoor locations. We recommend that generators are fitted with suppression kits to minimize the output.
